S6113A GOLDEN -- Includes certain substitute employees within the definition of teacher for retirement purposes

S6114A GOLDEN -- Increases disability benefits for certain persons employed by the Triborough bridge and tunnel authority who become disabled after having completed twenty years of service

S6115A GOLDEN -- Relates to the pension service credit for school administrator members of the New York state and local employees' retirement system

S6137A MALTESE -- Establishes a variable supplements fund for sanitation members of the New York city employees' retirement system

S6193A GOLDEN -- Establishes a twenty year retirement program for employees of the New York city transit authority who are subject to article 15 of such law

S6211A GOLDEN -- Grants additional service credit to members of NYCERS and BERS covered by chapter 96 of the laws of 2005 who make contributions based on physically nontaxing rates

S6283A RULES -- Extends World Trade Center disability presumption and death benefit provisions to Tier I and II members of the New York city teachers' retirement system

S6285 RULES -- Allows reinstatement in public teachers' retirement systems to certain members who were employed by the N.Y. city board of education

S6405 MARCELLINO -- Relates to the effectiveness of certain provisions giving members of a teachers' retirement system the right to buy back pension credit

S6733 MALTESE -- Increases certain special accidental death benefits for surviving spouses and children of certain police and fire personnel

S6756 MALTESE -- Establishes 20-year retirement program for deputy sheriffs who are subject to article 15 of the retirement and social security law

S6861 MALTESE -- Establishes a twenty-five year retirement program for members of the NYCERS or NYCBERS employed in construction laborer positions

S7071 LANZA -- Establishes a presumption with respect to certain diseases which result in disability for members of the uniformed force of a paid sanitation department

S7208A MALTESE -- Allows members of New York city police force the option of taking a lump sum monetary payment in lieu of terminal leave

S7209 MALTESE -- Increases pension benefits for certain captains in the New York city police department who have served in that title for fifteen years

S7292 MALTESE -- Expands the application of provisions for a reduced retirement age for certain Triborough bridge and tunnel authority employees

S7388 MALTESE -- Provides special accidental death benefits to deceased members of the department of sanitation of a city, town or village or limo or taxi inspectors

S7390 MALTESE -- Provides a special accidental death benefit to beneficiaries of deceased uniformed sanitation workers employed by a municipal entity

S7462 LANZA -- Authorizes the use of a one-year final salary base for determining benefit allowances for sanitation members of the New York city employees' retirement system

S7503 LANZA -- Establishes a variable supplements fund for transit members of the New York city employees' retirement system

S7517A LANZA -- Provides interest on certain benefits payable by the police and fire variable supplements funds to pension fund beneficiaries

S7519 TRUNZO -- Extends provisions providing for additional pension benefits for extended second public employment for certain retirees

S7569 GOLDEN -- Provides cost-of-living adjustments for retired sanitation members of the New York city employees' retirement system

S7606 MALTESE -- Relates to service credit for correction members of the New York city employees' retirement system

S7607 MALTESE -- Provides special accidental death benefit to certain peace officers and special officers employed in the city of New York

S7667 MALTESE -- Increases the accident disability retirement allowance for urban park rangers and associate urban park rangers employed by NYC to 75% of final average salary

S7668 MALTESE -- Establishes a twenty year retirement program for persons employed as urban park rangers and associate urban park rangers

S7864 LANZA -- Authorizes refunding of certain member contributions made by members of the transit managerial benevolent association

S7888 LANZA -- Provides death benefits and health insurance coverage for the family of N Y city firefighter Victor Navarra who died fighting at the World Trade Center site

S8008 LANZA -- Removes certain requirements regarding the timeliness of certain police force members for retirement

S8016A LANZA -- Grants Bruce Kerr a retroactive system membership date and tier I status in the New York city employees' retirement system

S8180 PADAVAN -- Allows retired members of the New York city police pension fund to collect their pensions while providing teaching service
